

Voters participating in this election must be residents of the Rogersville North Inside and Rogersville South Inside precincts, or live in Hawkins County and own property within the city limits of Rogersville (some restrictions apply).

**Early Voting** is May 15 – May 26, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. in the Election Office, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Courthouse Annex. **On Election Day**, you must vote at your precinct polling location – Rogersville North Inside at Hawkins Elementary, 1124 East Main Street; Rogersville South Inside at the original Courthouse, main floor, 100 East Main Street. The Election Day polls will be open 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.

(Note – If you have registered by mail and have not presented a valid photo ID at the election office, you must vote in person the first election in which you vote after registering.)

### **DEADLINES TO REGISTER AND CHANGE ADDRESS**

The registration deadline for the Rogersville municipal election is May 4, including property rights voters. If you have moved or changed your name since the last time you voted, download and complete a voter registration application to make your changes *now*. Otherwise, you will experience delays at the polls. Changes must be made in the system no later than five days before Election Day.

### **ABSENTEE BALLOT REQUESTS**

Requests for absentee ballots will be processed for the Rogersville municipal election no later than Friday, May 26, 2017. Due to delays we have experienced in mail delivery, it is suggested that we receive your request at least a week before this deadline.
